We currently have headlice at school in several of the classrooms. These little critters do appear at school from time-to-time and we urge you to be vigilant with your checking and treatment of the children. It is a normal thing that happens at school but very uncomfortable if it is not treated. If we can help in any way please let us know.

- Check every week. During outbreaks check daily after live headlice are found and treated.
- Brush hair every evening to reduce headlice numbers.
- Treat if you find LIVE insects or eggs within 1 cm of the scalp.
- Treat using a shampoo from your chemist. Repeat a week later.



Ask your chemist for advice and information.

This Friday at school the Year 5-6 students from Mahitahi have their "Bakesale" to help raise funds for their camp in term 4. If you can support this by sending the children to school with some cash so they can purchase some cakes and goodies from the students then we would be very appreciative.

Tell us of any changes in your circumstances please - Please remember to update the school office if you change address or phone numbers. We have had incidents recently where we cannot get in touch with families and this is a concern when children do not turn up to school and we are trying to establish a reason for their absence.

I would also ask that if you have any changes to family arrangements then you advise us so your children's interests are kept in mind.
