Congratulations to Rebecca Burrowes on winning the movie vouchers for the school survey. We hope you took advantage of the voucher in the school holidays.



Thank you all very much for the survey feedback. The BOT will compile a full report to you all about what our findings were from the 33 responses.


The data that was graphed is below and raises some points of view and direction.

- Communication and Relationships obviously has some development for some responders with a variance in some of the ratings.


Staff are employed for their Enthusiasm, Compassion and Confidence. How do they rate with these characteristics?
