BOT Comment - Teacher's Strike - Good Afternoon,



I'm sure the holidays are a bit of a memory now and all school families are right back into it. On an important note, I am sure you are aware that the union staff at Rakaia School are involved with some pay negotiations presently. This may result in strike action on the Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> August that will affect the whole day.

This is an important event, one that has not happened within 24 years. The Board of Trustees had a special meeting over the weekend to discuss how this may affect our community, staff and support team.

It is important to recognise that the Rakaia School Board of Trustees have elected to support our teachers on this occasion.

The Board has carefully considered the availability of teaching staff, and unfortunately decided that we can't provide the normal teaching services during the strike. It's important that you make alternative arrangements for the care of your child/children on the day of the strike.

The school will need to close during this strike.

Thank you for your understanding. The situation is dynamic and negotiations are continuing through the week, I will keep you updated with developments. Please contact me if you have any queries relating to this decision.
