Welcome to week 6 of term 3. By now you should have received an update on your child's progress through the HERO app. We are posting two this term and two next term including an end of year comment in term 4. We urge you to check these and make an appointment with the

classroom teacher if you have any questions or concerns.

The teachers are resetting goals twice a term however please remember the goals come from a level that can take a child 2 years or more to complete depending on their progress. If you are concerned your child is on a goal for a length of time then please check in with the teacher. The relationship between home and school is vital.

The goals after July first are aimed at being met by the end of December and hence you may see a drop in levels due to the fact that your child may have under 50% of



goals achieved at the higher level eg: level 4 and more than 50% at the lower level eg: level 3. The computer algorithm will select the level where more than 50% are achieved. The staff are making sure this is corrected with moderation and Overall Teacher Judgement to ensure progress is recorded accurately.

I know this is all a little frustrating however we are confident staff are on top of this work and we spent more time on it at our Teacher Only Day on Friday.

## **Teacher Appointments**
